ITEM No: 17-BOS- 1

Modification of Program Core Course in B.Tech Curriculum - Electrical & Electronics Engg. Department

The BOS resolved to recommend to the Senate for approval of the modified course contents of “EE200 – Circuit Theory” for B.Tech Curriculum of Electrical & Electronics Engineering Department. (*Annexure I*)

The BOS discussed in detail the proposal from Infosys for academic collaboration and starting of a PG Programme in Software Engineering to cater to their employee's educational qualification up-gradation. The members felt though it is desirable to start PG Programmes taking into account the needs of the Industry, the course contents for such programmes requires large discussion taking into account the skills / background of practicing Engineers. It is felt that an M.Tech course can be designed in the emerging areas where personnel from industries can be allowed to join this programme if they meet the eligibility norms of the Institute. A committee consisting of Head of the Departments of Computer, Information Technology, MACS with Dean (R&C), as Chairman was constituted to discuss the issues and concerns raised in this regard and to modify the proposal and submit to the Dean (Academic) office to be placed for the next Senate. However this requires policy decision involving all the Departments of the Institute. The members also suggested whether dual degree models available in IIT's can be introduced in NITK. The members also felt that the students admitted in such programme must have a clear cut exit conditions. The BOS felt the Senate can take a broader decision on the matter about the introduction of such integrated Ph.D programmes in the Institute. (*Annexure XIX*)

Introduction of New B.Tech and M.Tech courses in the Institute

The Chairman BOS informed the members that alumni of the Institute has come forwarded to support the starting of new B.Tech course on Gas Engineering. The Chairman also informed that the Institute has at present Centres of excellence carrying out inter disciplinary activities / research. Such centers should offer open elective in interdisciplinary areas and also plan to start new B.Tech / M.Tech Programmes in emerging areas engineering / technology. The Chairman welcomed the suggestion from members of BOS in this regard. Members of the BOS felt that strengthening of existing B.Tech programmes should be our top priority and starting of new programmes requires a broader discussion at the Departmental and Institute level. The Senate may take a policy decision in this regard.
